Cattle Protein

A high protein feed and mineral lick ideal for youngstock (from 4 months of age), stores and replacement heifers to support performance especially where low protein forages (straw, low protein silages e.g. cereal silages) form the base of the diet.

- Formulated to support dairy and suckler cows, breeding youngstock and store cattle using a combination of rumen available and high-quality rumen by-pass protein (DUP) to support performance, growth and milk output.
- Full mineral pack including chelated copper to help optimise fertility plus selenium, cobalt and vitamin E to support health and productivity.
- Do not feed to sheep.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Cattle – up to 500g/head/day.



Easy Lamber

A very high specification feed and mineral lick formulated to support in-lamb ewes. Feed from six weeks pre-lambing for best results.

- High energy content with a range of energy sources including propylene glycol, ideal for use where there is an increased risk of twin-lamb disease.
- A full mineral package including selenium yeast and chelated sources of manganese and zinc.
- Contains a yeast fermentation product to support ewe immune function and lamb vigour.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 35 sheep.

Typical Intakes Sheep – up to 150g/head/day.



High Energy

An energy, plus protein feed and mineral lick for year-round use to help support sheep and cattle at grass or alongside low protein and energy forages.

- High in energy, from several sources to help maintain body condition of stock and provide extra energy supplementation.
- Fortified with minerals, vitamins and trace elements to support good stock health and complement forages.
- Ideal for ewes pre-tupping and post-lambing and cattle requiring extra energy supplementation.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 35 sheep or 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Sheep – up to 150g/head/day, Lambs – up to 100g/head/day,
Cattle – up to 500g/head/day.



Magnesium

A seasonal high magnesium feed and mineral lick formulated for where there is an increased risk of grass staggers (hypomagnesaemia).

- Formulated to complement grazing using natural protein (no urea), high sugar content to encourage intakes and energy to help utilise protein in fresh grass.
- Magnesium to support where there is an increased risk of grass staggers in grazing livestock.
- Vitamins and minerals to support good stock health.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 35 sheep or 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Cattle – up to 500g/head/day,
Sheep – up to 150g/head/day.



Cattle Min

A mineral and vitamin lick for all cattle and calves at grass, or on high forage systems to support general performance and health.

- Ideal to balance forage and other non-mineralised feeding systems.
- Vitamins and minerals to help support immunity and general health of stock including chelated copper source to help optimise fertility in breeding stock.
- Do not feed to sheep.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Cattle – up to 150g/head/day.



Cattle Spring Mag

A seasonal high magnesium mineral lick formulated for use in spring where there is an increased risk of grass staggers (hypomagnesaemia).

- Formulated to complement spring grazing providing additional magnesium in a high sugar, palatable form to support where there is an increased risk of staggers.
- Includes vitamins and minerals to support good stock health and complement forages plus a source of chelated copper to help optimise fertility.
- Feed from pre-turnout for best results.
- Do not feed to sheep.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Cattle – up to 150g/head/day.



Dry Cow

A specifically formulated dry cow mineral and vitamin lick to support the requirements of dry cows and in-calf heifers to support cow and calf health and where the risk of milk fever exists.

- Optimal calcium and magnesium levels help support calving ease and are ideal for where there is a risk of milk fever.
- Full mineral and vitamin pack including selenium, zinc and vitamin E to help where there is a risk of key dry cow disorders.
- Chelated copper source to help support fertility and reproduction post-calving.
- Ideal for all dry dairy/suckler cows and heifers at grass or on high forage rations.
- Do not feed to sheep.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 15 cattle.

Typical Intakes Cattle – up to 150g/head/day.



Sheep Min

A mineral and vitamin lick for all sheep on forage systems to support performance all year round. Also suitable for cattle in a mix grazing situation.

- Formulated to complement forages and supplement where natural potential deficiencies may occur.
- A full mineral pack to support flock health and performance.
- Suitable for all ewes and lambs and mixed grazing situations.
- Offer one 25kg bucket per 35 sheep.

Typical Intakes Sheep – up to 30g/head/day.
