GUIDANCE FOR VISIT BY NWF



NWF Agriculture are committed to helping current and prospective customers by working with you to support your herd and flock health, cost control and performance during COVID-19. Farm visits, by NWF sales specialists, can now be undertaken providing everyone adheres to social distancing and follows the guidance below. A risk assessment has also been provided to each employee by the NWF Health & Safety team.

NWF FARM VISIT CHECKLIST

- 1 Heat Sensor Thermometer
- 2 Disposable Face Masks
- 3 Disposable Bags
- 4 Anti-Bacterial Wipes
- 5 Hand Sanitiser
- 6 Disposable Plastic Gloves



- NWF line manager permission will need be granted before a farm visit is arranged.
- NWF will make an appointment before a farm visit. During the call we will need to confirm that no persons on your farm are self isolating or showing symptoms of COVID-19. Social distancing must be adhered to during the visit and we will not be able to go into the farm office, house, buildings or vehicles.
- Prior to the farm visit we will have PPE in the vehicle, footwear will be clean and we will not have any symptoms of COVID-19.

ON FARM - NWF WILL MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING

Keep your Distance Remain 2 metres



2 metres apart at all times

- On arrival at the farm we will park in a safe area and maintain 2m social distancing in open outside areas. If we need to open/close gates we will wear gloves.
- If it is not possible to maintain 2m social distance we will wear a face mask and gloves.
- If we need to work on our laptop this will take place in the car or an open outside area. Information will be sent via email during or after the farm visit.
